Burtonelle: Created by Wilma W. Burton

- 1. Burtonelle a two-column free verse with a caesura (thought pause) running down the center between the two columns.
- 2. It is to be read horizontally with a slight pause between the columns
- 3. Usually lacks punctuation.
- 4. In the example I added a Cleave element in that the columns can be read top to bottom as well.
- 5. First lines bolded and serve as titles
