**Cinquain** Invented by Adelaide Crapsey

- 1. One five-line stanza is cinquain.
- 2. Syllable count: 2-4-6-8-2.
- 3. First example is single cinquain.
- 4. Second example puts two cinquain together. Reverse second stanza.
- 5. Third example puts them together and reverses: 2-4-6-8-2-2-8-6-4-2
