- 1. 18 lines. Villanelle variation.
- 2. Three Stanzas of six lines.
- Syllable Count: 8-6-8-8-6-8 8-6-8-6-8 6-6-6-8-8
 With rhyme scheme: a-b-a-b-c-d c-b-c-d-c-d b-c-b-c-e-e
 Last stanza: 6b- repeat line 2, 6c repeat line 5, 6b -repeat line 8, 6c-repeat line 11, and a couplet e-e.
- 4. Easiest was to proceed is to number the lines 1-8. Then add syllable count for each line, then add rhyme scheme.
