First two and last two lines have the same rhyme scheme. The center lines are all monorhymed. Indent the monorhymed lines.

Can be written in iambic tetrameter. Syllabic Count: 8 beats or syllable per line.

10 line: a-a-b-b-b-b-b-a-a 12 line: a-a-b-b-b-b-b-a-a
