Oddquain: Created by Glenda L. Hand. Usually unrhymed. 17 syllables in five lines.

Syllable Count: 1-3-5-7-1

Oddquain sequences: poems made up of Oddquain stanzas.

Crown Oddquains: a five stanza Oddquain sequence Reverse Oddquains: Reverse syllable patter 1-7-5-3-1 Mirror Oddquains: two stanzas: 1-3-5-7-1 1-7-5-3-1

Oddquain Butterflies: a merged mirror pattern.

Two Oddquains merge but use only one of the 1 syllables in the joining.

1-3-5-7-1-7-5-3-1.
