

Canopus

Starlight

All the unnamed, unseen stars lurk in dark
in time/space fabric print like polka dots.
Some advanced instruments might catch their spark.
Stars brighten some frigid and some hot spots
way beyond our preferred Goldilocks Zones.
Stars beyond telescope and rocket shots
unlikely to be our celestial clones.

Canopus:

1. Invented by Clement Wood
2. Form stresses a “continuous flow of thought”.
3. Canopus is second brightest star. Not visible above 37th degrees north of the northern hemisphere.
4. Seven lines.
5. Iambic pentameter or ten syllables per line.
6. Rhyme Scheme: a-b-a-b-c-b-c
