1. Find a list of prompts on the Internet or in books.
2. Select several prompts to combine into a poem.
3. This poem combined three prompts from a list of 30 Writing Prompts for National Poetry Month.

Make a list of seven words that have same vowel sounds and use in repetitive way throughout the poem. Words I chose were: sparge, star, barge, large, garage, barrage, charge, enlarge and recharge. I did not use surcharge.

Write a poem about weird fact or several odd facts that you know. I chose to write about Moon Pigeons and Mars Blueberries.

Write a poem in two sections about two completely different things. Have the title link both items together in a surprising way.
