Higgleday-Piggledies

1. Two stanzas of four lines.
2. First line is usually Higgledy-Piggledy but a variation called Double-Dactyls does not have that requirement but usually a nonsense word.
3. The 4th and 8th line rhyme. One dactyl.
4. Dactyl comes from Greek for finger. First syllable stressed as first joint largest then two unstressed syllables.
5. Line # 2 is always a proper name. I had to add so to Tyson's name for syllable count.
6. 6th line often nonsense word or word play.
