Lilibonelle: Invented by Bonnie Williams.

4 stanzas of 4 lines each. Each line of the first stanza repeats
as the first line of the following three stanzas.

There is a variation where an extra final line can be included.

You can play with rhyme schemes and rhythms.

You can add more lines but follow the pattern.

The rhyme scheme for this example is: a-b-c-b b-d-e-d c-f-g-f d-h-i-h
