Staccato: Created by Jan Turner. Two or more 6-line stanzas.

Rhyme Scheme: a-a-b-b-c-c

Syllable Count: 10-10-8-8-10-10

The example bolds the internal and repeat rhymes.

Lines 1 and 2 have an internal rhyme.

Line 3 and 6 have a two syllable repeat line. Two repeats in line 3.

One repeat in line 6. The repeat in line three have exclamation points
