Trijan Refrain: Created by Jan Turner. Three 9-line stanzas=27 lines.

Line one is the same in all three stanzas. A variation is not to repeat the same line at the beginning of each stanza. The first four syllables of line five are repeated as a double refrain for line 7 and 8.

Rhyme Scheme: a-b-a-b-c-c-d-d-refrain of first four words in line five c.

Syllable Count: 8-6-8-6-8-8-4-4 refrain 8

Example bolds the repeats.
