## Florette:

Invented by Jan Turner

- 1. Any number of quatrains or cinquains.
- 2. Designed to show flower growth by longer last line.
- 3. Syllable Count: 8-8-8-12
- 4. Rhyme Scheme: a-a-b-a c-c-d-c etc.
- 5. Cross rhymed with 8<sup>th</sup> syllable of line 3 to 8<sup>th</sup> syllable in line 4.
- 6. Enjambed line 3 and line 4 without endstop in line 3.
