- 1. 14 lines. Couplets.
- 2. Originally hendecasyllabic. Now 10 syllable lines.
- 3. Two rhymes. Capital A and B are the repeat lines.
- 4. Pattern: A-B a-A b-B a-A b-B a-A B-A
