Kyrielle Hymn:

- 1. American invented form closer to English Hymnal Measure than with French Kyrielle. Both have refrain in common.
- 2. Any number of cinquains. Five-line poems.
- 3. Metric Count: Lines 1,3,5 iambic tetrameter. Lines 2 and 4 lambic trimeter. Or if updating to Syllable Count: 8-6-8-6-8
- 4. The refrain is the fifth line of each stanza.
- 5. Rhyme Scheme: a-b-a-b-R c-d-c-d-R etc. The R or refrain does not have to rhyme with the other end words of the stanza.
