- 1<sup>ac</sup> stanza: mono-rnymed 5 lines with same synaple count of 9
  2<sup>nd</sup> stanza: a quatrain
  3<sup>rd</sup> stanza: an enclosed rhyme
  4<sup>th</sup> stanza: a rhyme
  5<sup>th</sup> stanza: a tail-rhyme: a rhyming short line
  6<sup>th</sup> stanza: a terza-rima a-b-a
  7<sup>th</sup> -9<sup>th</sup> stanza: three rhyming couplets with syllable count of 8
  10<sup>th</sup> stanza: a single verse: one line
  11<sup>th</sup> stanza: a concluding verse that may or may not rhyme with the 10<sup>th</sup> stanza
