## Quadrilew:

Introduced by C.V.G. Lewis

- 1. Alternate syllabic patterns and tumbling refrain.
- 2. Sixteen lines. Four quatrains.
- 3. Syllable Count: 5-6-5-6 6-5-6-5 5-6-5-6 6-5-6-5
- 4. The lines in the first stanza are repeated as tumbling rhyme in the first line of the subsequent stanzas. Line 2 is repeated as line 5. Line 3 as line 9. Line 4 as line 13.
- 5. Rhyme Scheme: a-B1-A-B2 B1-c-b-c A-d-a-d B2-c-b-c Upper case the refrain.
