- 2. Metric: Stanzas 1 & 3 are iambic pentameter. Stanza 2=iambic Line 1 and 5-dimeter. Line 3 is pentameter. Line 2 & 4 are tetrameter.
- 3. Converted to Syllable Count: Stanza 1= 10 Stanza 2= 4-8-10-8-4 Stanza3=10
- 4. Rhyme Scheme: A-b-a-b-b a-c-A-c-a d-a-d-a-A Capital letters is repeat line.
