- 2. Lines 1-2-5 6 are iambic pentameter. Lines 3 and 4 are iambic tetrameter.
- 3. If converted to syllable counts; 10-10-8-8-10-10
- 4. Rhyme Scheme: a-a-b-b-c-c d-d-e-e-f-f g-g-h-h-i-i etc.
- 5. Internal rhyme midway in lines 1 and 2. Two syllable refrain repeated twice at beginning of line 3 and once beginning of line 6.
