- 2. Metric: iambic tetrameter or pentameter or 8 or 10 syllables per line.
- 3. Rhyme Scheme: a-a-b-b-b-C-C d-d-e-e-e-C-C
- 4. The last two lines of the first stanza are repeated as last two line refrain of any other stanzas.
