- 1. Two or more 6-line stanzas
- 2. Rhyme Scheme: a-a-b-b-c-c-
- 3. Syllable Count: 10-10-8-8-10-10
- 4. Two syllable repeat in Lines 3 and 6.
- 5. The repeat is for strong emotion, instruction, strong observation.
- 6. Line 3 has two repeats each followed by exclamation point,
- 7. Line 6 has one repeat followed with or without an exclamation point.
- 8 Line #1 and #2 have internal rhymes. Try for 5th and 6th syllables.
- 9. In this poem the repeats are bolded. The internal rhymes in italics.
