Triolet:

- 1. French form. Two rhymes. 8-line stanzas.
- 2. Two refrain lines in line 1 and 4 and then line 7.
- 3. Line 2 reappears as line 8. A and B are retrains.
- 4. The triolet rhymes A-B-a-A-a-b-A-B
- 5. All the a rhymes are 8 syllable lines.
- 6. All the b rhymes are 6 syllable lines.
- 7. Sometimes two stanzas are created between lines five and six for a quintet and a triplet.
