- 1. Any number of sixains. 6-line stanzas. or octaves 8-line stanzas.
- 2. Syllable Count: 8-8-8-8-12-12 in sixains.14-14-8-8-8-8-14-14 in octaves.
- 3. Rhyme Schemes: sixains: a-a-b-b-c-c d-d-e-e-f-f octaves: a-a-b-b-c-c-d-d e-e-f-f-g-g-i-i
- 4. In sixains- repeating the first 4 syllables of line 1 as the last 4 syllables of line 6. In octaves: repeating the first 10 syllables of line 1 as the last 10 syllables of line 8.
